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From the Pastor's Desk:

Stories We Tell

The season of Lent has traditionally been a time of prayer, fasting, repentance, and benevolence. It is also a time where many people across Christian traditions pick up a new discipline, often choosing to give up a luxury (like chocolate) or something that has been harmful (like smoking). Others attempt to add something that can be life-giving, such as reading scripture every day, or completing sun-salutations each morning. One year while I was in seminary, I attempted to give up going out for coffee during Lent... a practice that proved to be difficult during final exams!

This Lent, as we continue to gather around the stories of God within scripture and the stories of individuals within our congregation, I wonder what a worthwhile practice might be for us as we seek to grow closer to God and deepen our understanding of how God is at work in the world around us. Rather than viewing Lent as an opportunity for a six-week diet or an excuse to dedicate time to a new hobby, perhaps we can use

this season to ask ourselves: how can we create space this Lent to recognize God at work in our lives? Notice how this question is worded: you are not creating space *so that God can work in your life... God is already at work in your life, but oftentimes our days are too crowded for us to notice the Divine's presence. The space we create isn't for God, it's for us! God is always present to us, usually in spite of us, not because of us.*

The practice of storytelling becomes vital for our community this Lent because it forces us to create space, to slow down, to hush our busy minds, and listen to God at work in others, so that we, in turn, might see how is God at work through us.

A fellow pastor and good friend of mine recently started a podcast where he shared a story from his childhood. However, he did not tell this story because he thought to tell it on his own, but rather a friend asked him one day if he could tell her a



story that revealed something about who he is. This prompt opened up his memories and imagination, and the story that rose out of his being was one about his father. On summer nights, my friend's father would take him up on the roof of their California home to drink cold root beer and watch the stars. It was there that he asked his father what the word "divorce" meant. And it was there that his father promised him that he would never have to worry about the meaning of that word. Yet only a few years later, my friend found himself as a child caught in the messiness of his parents crumbling relationship and consequent divorce.

My friend reflected on how that story of his father shaped his relationships, especially the relationships he now has with his wife and children. Yet this story also shaped his understanding and relationship with God, who he felt was intimately present on those summer nights on the roof, as well as during family court proceedings. The story of his father was also a story about God - how God was a source of comfort to him during the ups and downs of his life.

With my friend's story in mind, I wonder... can you tell a story that reveals something about who you are? Can you tell a story that reveals something about how you've experienced God?

During this season of Lent, I encourage you to tell these stories. Tell them to yourself, to a trusted friend or to your partner - tell these stories and listen to them as well, as a Lenten practice of making space to recognize God at work in your life and in the community.
