The responsibilities for this position include: accompanying the rehearsals and performances of the two children's choirs (Wednesday evening rehearsals 6:30-8:15 pm from September through May; worship services on the second and fourth Sundays of the month during the program year); playing piano for the children's Christmas pageant and spring musical; accompanying St. Mike's Tykes (preschool Sunday School class) in worship 3-4 times a year; meeting with the Director of Children's Music to coordinate music plans and work together to create a fun and productive environment for children's and youth learning and singing.

*Position Description*

The duties and responsibilities of the Children's Choir Accompanist include but are not limited to the following:

1. Accompany two children's choirs for rehearsals, when they sing as part of Sunday morning worship, and the Sunday School Christmas program and spring musical. Weekly rehearsals are most often on Wednesdays from 6:30-7:15 pm and 7:30 pm to 8:15 pm from September through May. The children's choirs sing on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month from September through May and at special services such as Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve, and Ash Wednesday.
2. Accompany the St. Mike's Tykes when they sing at worship (often 3-4 times a year).
3. Meet as necessary with the Director of Children's Music to coordinate music plans for Sunday worship and other services that may be appropriate.
4. Provide support and guidance to the Director of Children's Music regarding maintenance of a productive environment for learning and singing.
5. Notify the Director of Children's Music in advance of times you need to be away so that arrangements can be made for a substitute pianist to accompany the children and that the substitute may be reimbursed.
