Included are the "Road through Jerusalem" sticker activity set, corresponding videos and activities, and our Holy Week schedule at St. Michael's.



Activity:

Decorate Your Door

In our tradition at St. Michael's we use palms to wave around to remember and celebrate the time Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. Other places in the world gather flowers, tree branches, etc. from their own back yard to wave instead of palm branches. Go on a walk and see what you can find in your neighborhood you could use to decorate your door for Palm Sunday. If there isn't much in bloom, decorate your door with paper flowers!

Activity:

Egg-and-Spoon Race

Each player gets a spoon and an egg (hardboiled or plastic). Each team must carry their egg on their spoon from the starting line to a turnaround point and back again. Then, the egg is passed off to a teammate who takes their turn. If the egg is dropped, the player must stop and retrieve it.

Activity:

Sunrise

Take a coffee filter and washable markers. Make a design to create a sun. Take a wet paint brush or spray bottle with water and watch as the colors from your marker bleed together to make your sunrise!



Communion Bread Recipe

Sift dry ingredients 3 times:

- o 2 cups whole wheat flour
- o 1 cup white flour
- o 1 & 1/4 heaping teaspoon baking powder
- o 1 & 1/4 teaspoon salt

Cut in oil: 1 Tablespoon + 1 teaspoon oil

Mix water & sweetener. Add & mix well.

- o 3/4 cup + 2 Tablespoons very hot water
- o 3 Tablespoons honey
- o 3 Tablespoons molasses

Dough should be sticky

Divide and roll 1/4 inch thick circles

Mark with cross

Bake at 350o for 10 minutes

Remove and brush with oil

Bake an additional 5—8 minutes more at 350o

Cool

Yields approximately 4 loaves 8" round

**Hint from experienced bakers: knead dough and then let it rest before rolling. Each batch makes four loaves.
