

Reflection Questions for Sunday, May 17

In Acts, the apostle Paul speaks to the Athenians about God using an image he saw in their city and poetry from their poet Aratus. Has there ever been a time when you were trying to explain your faith or understanding of God to people whose experience was different from yours? How did you find a common language or understanding?

If you were to give a "testimony" about how God has been present in your life (good times or hard times), how would you describe this experience?

Counter to Paul using the image of an "unknown God," Jesus talks of a God that the disciples do know. They know God by the love revealed and are called to show that love to others. Who has revealed God's love to you...and how? How do you share that testimony with others?
